I. Approval of Minutes

1. Minutes were read and approved.

II. Financial Report

1. Vice President, Marius Mutayoba reported that there was \$270.98 spent this week. The pizza party cost was \$41.55. There was \$223.67 spent on the Homecoming flowers, and king and queen sets. There was \$5.76 spent on office supplies.
