1. The Student Government Association convened at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 12, 2004, in the Student Center Conference Room, with President Katrina Johansen presiding.

3. The members signed up to bring items for the time capsule. All items will be due on March 31.
4. Cara presented the revised budget and announced that the lanyards would not be purchased due to shortage of funds. The members agreed on a few more changes and the final proposal will be presented at the next meeting.
5. Katrina reminded the members that Discover Northeast will be on March 28, 2004. She also mentioned that brochures will be need to be ordered for the display.
6. Special Events Coordinator Genevieve Allou asked the members if they would help in publicizing the Black History Month movies that will be played each Thursday this month. She reported that there has been a very low turnout and would like attendance to improve.

The members agreed to set up a voter registration table for students outside the theatre during the presentation. The members also discussed having a panel of politicians to discuss with students what it means to be a member of a political party during this semester or possibly next fall.

8. Katrina attended the Administrative Services Standing Committee meeting and reported that the committee approved changes to the Fire Safety Code. She also attended the Board of Governor's meeting and informed them of the time capsule burial date. The SGA members agreed that formal invitations to the time capsule burial will be sent to the Board members.
9. Heather announced that the website is done except for a few minor changes.
10. Marshall reported that two candidates for the Vice President of Educational Services position will be interviewed in the next week and the final candidate will be named in mid-March.
