1. The Student Government Association convened at 5:01 p.m. on Thursday, March 25, 2004, in the Student Center Conference Room, with President Katrina Johansen presiding.
2. Minutes of the March 18, 2004, Student Government Association meeting were acknowledged and approved.
3. Marshall informed the members that the plaque for the time capsule has been designed and will be presented to the members at a later date.
4. Rick mentioned that the student speaker at graduation will definitely be the student who gives the welcome speech at the ceremony. Any graduating members who are interested need to have a outline of their speech to him by March 31.
5. Katrina informed the members that all security issues need to be typed up in a formal report and given to her. The members agreed to make up a survey involving campus security to give to students.
6. Cara presented the updated budget to the members, pointing out the most recent office supply purchases from the bookstore.
7. Election Coordinator Cara Snider reminded the members that sophomore applications are available now and due on April 2. Katrina added that the new officers for the 2004-2005 school year are President- Marshall Rosenblad, Vice President- Genevieve Allou, and Secretary- Caroline Allou.
